WINEMAKER NOTES

The 1999 San Saba Merlot has a wonderful garnet color with brilliant clarity. It has aromas of Bing cherries and dried cherries with hints of white chocolate, toast, smoke, tea, mint, and tobacco.

The wine is full bodied with predominate flavors of cherries, chocolate, clove and allspice. There is a long spicy finish intertwined with generous amounts of oak, the result of over twenty four months of oak aging.

San Saba Merlot 1999 is a hearty wine that should be enjoyed with strong flavored foods such as gorgonzola cheese, grilled steaks or hearty pasta.
